## Items for Angelitos Families to Bring

Please label everything to avoid confusion and lost belongings. -Thank You!

- Water bottle (stays at school all week, please take home to wash on weekends)
- Blanket, pillow and comfort item for rest time (Please make sure this all fits in your child's cubby)
- Extra clothing and plastic bags (at least two of everything, this can stay in the cubby until it gets used)
- Sunscreen (stays at school all year, applied by teachers on sunny days)
- Weather appropriate gear depending on the season (sun hat, raincoat, rain boots, warm jacket, hat, mittens, etc.)
- Family photo (stays at school all year)
- **Toothbrush** (we provide basic toothpaste w/ fluoride please provide alternative if you want your child to use something else)

## **Angelitos Daily Schedule**

**8:00-8:55** AM: Free choice time in the classroom.

8:55 AM: Clean up for circle.

9:05-9:30 AM: Circle.

**9:35-10:00** AM: Morning snack.

**10:00** AM: Transition into project time.

**10:00-11:00** AM: Project time.

**11:00** AM: Clean up, bathroom break, transition outside.

**11:15-11:55** AM: Outside exploration.

12:00-12:30 PM: Lunch

**12:30-1:00** PM: Story time/teacher read aloud.

1:00-2:00 PM: Rest time.

**2:00** PM: Quiet book reading/mat activities for children who are awake.

2:30-3:00 PM: Quiet activities.

3:00 PM: Afternoon snack.

3:30 PM: Transition outside.

3:45-4:40: Outside exploration.

4:45 PM: Transition inside.

**5:00** PM: All children are picked up by this time and children scheduled to stay until 5:30 combine with the Pumas Class.

\*\*Schedule may vary according to time of year and/or classroom flow and daily energy. Please also note that drop off is between 8 and 9 am. We ask that all families arrive by 8:45 in order to give children ample time to transition prior to circle time.
